SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority Under Section 8151, Department of Defense
Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2002 (Public Law 107-117)

1. Pursuant to Section 8151, Department of Defense Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2002, (Public Law 107-117) (extract at Tab B), the Under Secretary of Defense (Personnel and Readiness) has delegated to the Secretaries of the Military Departments the authority and responsibility to exercise the provisions of Title 38, United States Code, Section 7403(g), that authorizes the Department of Defense's use of the Secretary of Veterans Affairs' authority regarding the appointment of certain civilian health care professional occupations listed in Title 38 United States Code, Section 7403(a)(2), as well as the following: Pharmacists, Audiologists, and Dental Hygienists (Tab C).

2. Accordingly, since this falls within the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Manpower and Reserve Affairs) (ASA(M&RA)) responsibilities under General Order 1, I request that you re-delegate this authority to the ASA(M&RA). The proposed delegation of authority at Tab A will accomplish this purpose. I have coordinated this proposed delegation **with the Office of the General Counsel.**
